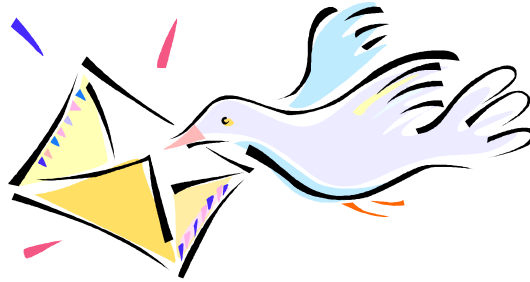


## Camp Yomawha Week 8: Carnival Week
