COUNSELING OPPORTUNITIES

SPECIALIST OPPORTUNITIES

Unit Head
 (1 Position) Salary Based on Experience
 Responsible for direct supervision of junior and senior counselors as well as campers in the unit. Minimum education: College graduate with 3 years youth related supervisory experience.

Assistant Unit Head
 (1 Position) Salary Based on Experience
 Assisting Unit Heads in supervision of staff and campers. Primary focus is with younger campers with potential to work with other age groups. Minimum education: college graduate with youth related supervisory experience.

Trip Leader/CIT Director
 (1 Position) \$2,800-\$3,200/season
 Responsible for planning and teaching leadership workshops for our CIT program. Also responsible for coordinating and overseeing logistics on trips. Minimum age: 21 with experience supervising teens.

Senior Counselor
 (16 Positions) \$1,500-\$2,450/season
 Direct responsibility for a group of approximately 12-15 campers. Assisted by a co-counselor or junior counselor. Minimum education: 1 year college or similar experience.

Special Needs Coordinator
 (1 Position) Salary Based on Experience
 Responsible for working with unit heads and counselors to create the best possible experience for campers with special needs. Direct communication with parents of these campers. Minimum education: Masters with experience working with special needs children and related supervisory experience.

Junior Counselor
 (16 Positions) \$1,250-\$1,650/season
 Assisting a senior counselor with a group of approximately 12-15 campers. Minimum education: entering senior year of high school, entering college or similar experience.

Special needs Counselors
 (2-4 Positions) \$1,400-\$2,600/season
 Assisting Special Needs Coordinator with specific campers and groups. Minimum Education: entering senior year of high school or enrolled college or similar experience.

Program Coordinator
 (1 Position) \$1,800-\$2,950/season
 Responsible for all supplies on camp, including transport (via bus) from the Y to HCK and back to the Y. Also responsible for liaising with specialists regarding special events and special supplies needed. Minimum age: 21 with supervisory experience.

Arts and Crafts Specialist
 (1 Position) \$3,000-\$3,200/season
 Develop and deliver a creative arts and crafts program. Responsible for all art programming on camp. Minimum education: college graduate or equivalent with experience in specialty area.

Climbing Wall/Team Building Specialist
 (1 Position) \$3,000-\$3,250/season
 Plan and develop a program on low ropes course and challenge wall tower. Minimum education: college graduate or equivalent with experience in specialty area.

Assistant Climbing Wall/Team Building Specialist
 (3 positions) \$1,500-\$2,800/season
 Assist Climbing Wall Specialist with implementation and supervision of rope elements. Must be enrolled college or similar experience.

Jewish Culture Specialist
 (1 Position) \$3,000-\$3,200/season
 Responsible for creating and delivering Judaic curriculum. Also responsible for Oneg Shabbat programming. Minimum education: college graduate with experience in specialty area.

Music Specialist/Song Leader
 (1 Position) \$3,000-\$3,200/season
 Responsible for all music on camp including all camp programs. Minimum education: college graduate or equivalent with experience in specialty area.

Nature Specialist
 (1 Position) \$3,000-\$3,200/season
 Develop and deliver a creative nature program for all campers. Responsible for camp garden and all nature related activities. Minimum education: college graduate or equivalent with experience in specialty area.

Sports Specialist
 (1 Position) \$3,000-\$3,200/season
 Responsible for teaching and supervising athletic activities on camp. Minimum education: college graduate or equivalent with experience in specialty area.

Assistant Sports Specialist
 (1 Position) \$1,600-\$2,400/season
 Assisting Sports Specialist with any sport programming on camp. Must be at least 1 year through college or similar experience.

Theater and Dance Specialist
 (1 Position) \$3,000-\$3,200/season
 Plan and develop all dance and theater related curriculum. Minimum education: college graduate or equivalent with experience in specialty area.
